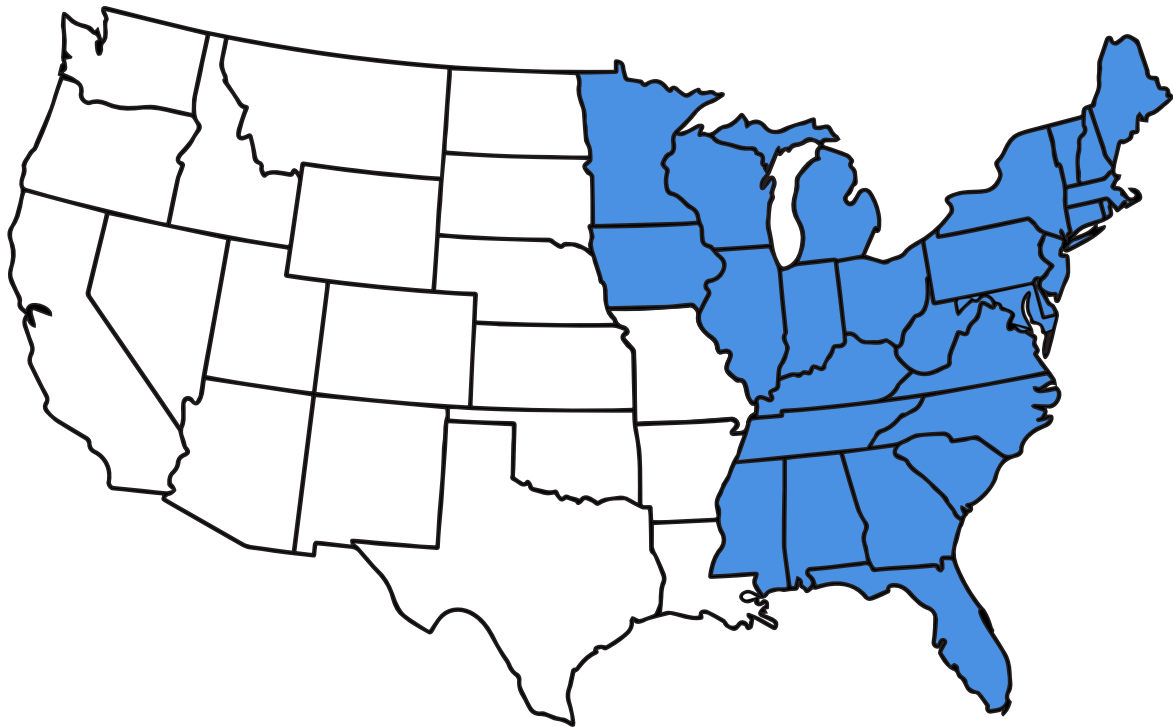

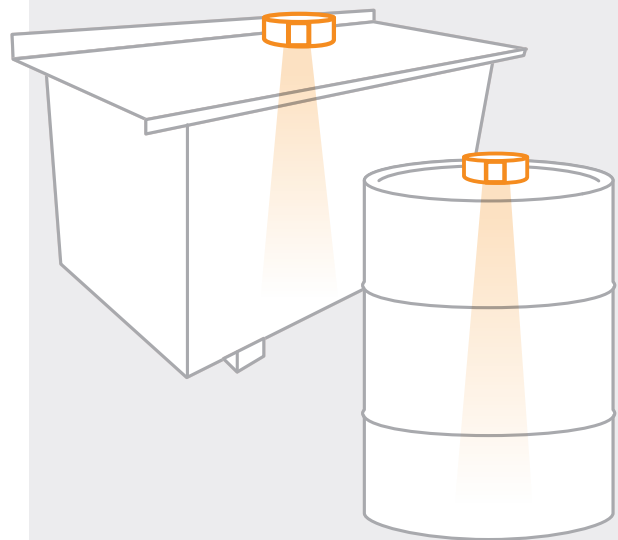

ENFINITE Comments on EPA CWT Study Regarding PFAS

Earlier this year, ENFINITE filed comments with the EPA on behalf of its members regarding the agency's proposal for a generic information collection request (ICR) from members who operate Centralized Wastewater Treatment facilities. ENFINITE is concerned that the ICR of members is too broad and would provide the EPA unfettered access and oversight over information collection from members.

ORG Chem Group Sells Evansville & Troy, IN to CGH-EV

ORG CHEM Group, LLC has sold the assets and business activities of their Evansville and Troy, Indiana, locations to CGH-EV, Inc. Paul and Dave Carson are the owners of CGH-EV, Inc. CGH-EV, Inc. will continue to provide toll processing services utilizing the core high vacuum evaporation technology employed some 46 years ago.

New EPA Administrator Lee Zeldin Takes Office

The Senate Environment and Public Works Committee voted 11-8 on January 23, 2025, to recommend Lee Zeldin to the full Senate for confirmation as the next U.S. EPA administrator. Chairman Shelley Moore Capito, R-W.Va. said Zeldin is the right candidate to help the environment as well as the economy, noting that the country has long felt the "negative impacts of EPA regulatory overreach [over the] years, devastating portions of our state's economy and putting my constituents out of work." Zeldin was sworn in on January 29, 2025.

Trump's Executive Order to Freeze New Regulatory Actions

President Trump signed an Executive Order that prohibits agencies (including EPA) from proposing or issuing new rules

until a new appointee or designate reviews and approves the rule. It also requires agencies to consider postponing, for 60 days, the effective date of rules that have been issued.

Valicor Releases Inaugural Sustainability Report

ENFINITE Member Valicor Environmental Services released its inaugural sustainability report. The report emphasizes the company's dedication to transparency and its role in driving sustainable practices within the industrial waste and water management sector. "As a company dedicated to shaping a more sustainable world, this report serves as both a reflection of our progress and a blueprint for the future," said Steve Hopper, Chief Executive Officer.

Crystal Clean Expands West

ENFINITE Member Crystal Clean announced it has expanded its west coast network with the acquisition of World Wide Recovery Systems and Yuma Environmental Services. Brian Recatto, President & CEO of Crystal Clean, commented, "The acquisitions of WRS has tremendous potential to advance our strategic priorities with increased access to the western U.S. market, synergies with our branch network and industrial services footprint, and an enhanced value proposition to large national accounts."

Republic Acquires Shamrock Environmental

Shamrock Environmental headquartered in North Carolina has been acquired by Republic Services. The company was advised by ENFINITE Member Brown Gibbons Lang & Co.'s Environmental Infrastructure investment banking team. Shamrock is a provider of industrial waste and wastewater treatment services. The company operates six permitted centralized wastewater treatment facilities and several solidification sites, collecting and transporting recurring liquid waste.

EPA Tasked with Rethinking Its Mission Under Trump Executive Orders

New EPA Administrator Lee Zeldin will need to hit the ground running to keep up with the requirements and deadlines set in motion on the first day of the Trump Administration.

Four executive orders (EOs) issued by the Trump Administration on January 20, 2025, direct the EPA to immediately begin taking a series of sharp policy and administrative shifts in the weeks and months ahead. Three presidential actions (PAs) issued on the same day will directly impact EPA policy and staffing.

Below is a list of the relevant EOs and PAs, followed by brief synopses and an overview of what businesses can expect.

Executive Orders:

- EO 14154 – Unleashing American Energy
- EO 14156 – Declaring a National Energy Emergency
- EO 14153 – Unleashing Alaska’s Extraordinary Resource Potential
- EO 14162 – Putting America First in International Environmental Agreements

Presidential Actions

- Regulatory Freeze Pending Review
- Return to In-Person Work
- Restoring Accountability for Career Senior Executives

Zeldin was sworn in on Jan. 30, 2025, pledging to “work closely with the dedicated career officials at the agency to fulfill the agency’s mission to protect human health and the environment.”



Unleashing American Energy

EO 14154 sets a deadline of Feb. 19, 2025, for EPA to:

- Report “on the legality and continuing applicability” of the 2009 endangerment finding for greenhouse gases, a foundational ruling for federal climate change regulations for vehicles and power plants.
- Develop action plans to suspend, revise or rescind all agency actions identified as:
 - ▶ unduly burdensome on the identification, development, or use of domestic energy resources, focusing on oil, natural gas, coal, hydropower, biofuels, critical mineral and nuclear energy resources
 - ▶ or that do not promote “true consumer choices” for vehicles and appliances

EO 14154 also directs EPA to issue guidance by March 21, 2025, to address the “harmful and detrimental inadequacies” used in the existing calculation of the social cost of carbon and consider eliminating altogether the social cost of carbon

calculation from any federal permitting or regulatory decision.”

In addition, EO 14154 states that it is “terminating the Green New Deal” and requires EPA and other agencies to immediately pause the disbursement of funds appropriated through the Inflation Reduction Act or the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act. It requires the agencies to review their processes, policies, and programs for issuing grants, loans, contracts, or any other financial disbursements of such appropriated funds for consistency with the law and the policy outlined in the Executive Order and to submit a report on their findings within 90 days. The impact of this pause on funding awards that had already been announced is unclear.



Declaring a National Energy Emergency

EO 14156 imposes various requirements on the EPA including identifying any emergency and other authorities to facilitate the supply, refining and transportation of energy in the United States. It calls for summary reports by EPA every 30 days thereafter. Notably, this EO defines energy to mean “crude oil, natural gas, lease condensates, natural gas liquids, refined petroleum products, uranium, coal, biofuels, geothermal heat, the kinetic movement of flowing water, and critical minerals but not solar or wind.”

Unleashing Alaska’s Extraordinary Resource Potential

Under EO 14153, the EPA and the heads of all executive departments and agencies are required to exercise all lawful authority and discretion to prioritize the development of Alaska LNG potential, including the permitting of all necessary pipeline and export infrastructure, giving due consideration to the economic and national security benefits associated with such development.

Putting America First in International Environmental Agreements

This PA expresses the intent of the United States to withdraw from the Paris Climate Agreement. EPA has 30 days to submit a report detailing its actions to revoke or rescind policies that were implemented to advance the International Climate Finance Plan.

Presidential Actions

Regulatory Freeze Pending Review

EPA is prohibited from proposing or issuing any rule until Administrator Zeldin reviews and approves the rule, which is likely to result in a flurry of proposed rules for the new EPA Administrator to review. By way of example, on January 21, 2025, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) withdrew EPA’s Proposed Rule, “Clean Water Act Effluent Limitations Guidelines

(ELG) and Standards for PFAS Manufacturers Under the Organic Chemicals, Plastics and Synthetic Fibers (OCSFP) Point Source Category.” It is unclear whether this will impact EPA’s draft water quality criteria for perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (PFOS), and perfluorobutane sulfonic acid (PFBS) which was listed as open for public comment until Feb. 24, 2025.

What to Expect

With the lightning speed of the release of these new orders and directives, the acting EPA administrator reportedly issued a directive on January 24, 2025, that instructed all EPA staff to halt communications with external parties pending further instructions, with a few limited exceptions.

Some regions appear to be continuing communications with private parties on matters that have already been settled and where implementation of the settlement is underway, such as a remedial action under a CERCLA consent decree. It is unclear if this directive will be lifted now that Administrator Zeldin is in place and can communicate the objectives and policies of the EPA under the new administration.

Staffing at EPA to get all this work done could also be an issue. The Trump Administration’s hiring freeze applies to almost all executive departments and agencies. The PA on Return to In-Person Work could result in longtime EPA employees leaving the agency. It requires EPA to terminate remote work arrangements. On Jan. 24, 2025, EPA issued a “return-to-office” order to agency employees requiring that they return to their in-person worksites “as soon as practicable and not later than Feb. 24, 2025.”

In furtherance of the administration’s stated goal of reducing the federal workforce, most EPA staff received an email from the Office of Personnel Management offering a buyout under which employees may resign and receive pay through the end of September. The email warned employees that those who do not accept the buyout offer may face an uncertain future at the agency and set a Feb. 6, 2025, deadline for employees to accept the buyout offer. Congressional Democrats have taken the position that Trump lacks authority to offer to pay staff through

the end of the fiscal year, noting that the federal government is currently funded only through March 14, 2025.

Under the PA on “Restoring Accountability for Career Senior Executives,” EPA is required to implement a Career “Senior Executive Service” Performance Plan and reassign EPA SES personnel to ensure that their skills are “optimally aligned” to implement the agenda of the Trump Administration. This order will likely result in the reassignment of some EPA personnel to new subject matter areas and positions.

In addition, it is unclear how the recent trio of Trump Executive Orders taking aim at DEI and gender policies may impact EPA employees.

It also remains to be seen whether the issued-then-rescinded OMB pause on funding of all federal grants, loan, and other forms of financial assistance may necessitate a reduction in EPA’s work force.

All of these actions combined will likely result in a reduction of EPA staff who are knowledgeable about their subject area.

What This Means for Private Companies and Others

Delay and some level of confusion or inconsistency in EPA positions should be expected in the short term. EPA staff may not have much more information than regulated companies do, and staff will be trying to figure out how to proceed in implementing the flurry of orders and directives from the new administration.

With staff reassignments and resignations anticipated, experienced EPA employees may be hard to come by. Positions taken by EPA in ongoing negotiations may change suddenly and dramatically.

Companies should be patient as the agency works through the changes brought about by the new administration. The shift in priorities of the new administration also provides an opening for companies to argue that their position is a “common sense” solution and that any proposed project will spur business and job creation.

For some companies, these changes may open significant opportunities and new points of leverage. Companies should feel free to raise arguments and positions rejected by EPA under the prior administration.

Increased Action by States

In addition to the confusion on the federal level, it is likely that some states will take aggressive action to advance their environmental initiatives and new regulatory requirements and standards on the state level should be anticipated. By way of example, leaders of the California Air Resources Board (CARB) are vowing to defend their authority to implement stringent climate and clean air regulations.

New York also recently passed a Climate Change Superfund Law that imposes retroactive strict, joint and several liability on companies that New York contends have had an outsized impact on climate change and requires these “responsible parties” to make payments to a fund to be used for infrastructure and other projects that will mitigate the impacts of climate change. ■

INTRODUCING **ENFINITE**

The Industrial Liquid Recyclers Association

On November 13, 2024, NORA, An Association of Responsible Recyclers announced it was rebranding as *ENFINITE*: The Industrial Liquid Recyclers Association.

Forty years ago, NORA was founded by four companies as the National Oil Recyclers Association. Following several mergers and member diversification into wastewater, antifreeze, filters, solvents and more, the association was renamed NORA, An Association of Responsible Recyclers in 2001.

Over the last 24 years, the association has grown to over 300 members that have continued to diversify into collecting and recycling a wide variety of industrial liquids as well as a providing a wide array of industrial and environmental services.

“As our industry continues to evolve, it is important that the association evolves as well so that it reflects the important work our members provide to protect the environment,” stated *ENFINITE* Executive Director Scott D. Parker. “We are excited to share our new brand with members and the industry as we prepare to serve members for the next 40 years no matter what the future holds.”

This was not a rash decision. In fact, the leaders of the association have been working on this for a few years. The Board of Directors held a professionally facilitated strategy meeting in Chicago. This led to hiring a marketing firm to conduct interviews and focus groups with members to develop the new brand.

Name Concept

ENFINITE combines the words environment and infinite. This recognizes the importance of the work members do to recycle

and reuse industrial liquid waste to protect the environment while seeing infinite potential in creating a circular economy where nothing goes to waste.

Logo Concept

The logo design incorporates a liquid drop with the concept of a Möbius strip. Clearly, the liquid drop refers to the billions of industrial liquid gallons members collect and recycle or reuse each year. A Möbius strip can be formed by attaching the ends of a strip of paper together with a half-twist and is a non-orientable surface, meaning that within it one cannot consistently distinguish clockwise from counterclockwise turns.

Perhaps the most recognizable graphic designs using a Möbius strip is the three-arrow logo for recycling. In addition, the middle portion of the *ENFINITE* logo is modeled after the sideways figure eight design representing infinity.

The Möbius strip defies possibilities. And so does the work of *ENFINITE* members. Members create usability out of liquids others see as waste, with a process that requires an intimate knowledge of these industrial fluids.

“*ENFINITE* members do seemingly impossible work,” stated Parker. “They take the industrial liquid waste that burdens partner companies and transform it into usable products. Through innovative purification processes we recycle, reuse, and dispose of these fluids—creating a circular economy that’s environmentally friendly.”

In keeping with its legacy, *ENFINITE* will continue to connect, educate and protect the industrial liquid recycling industry, and adjacent services.

As part of the rebrand process, all member websites were reviewed and a complete list of products and services being offered by members was compiled. It is clear that members provide much more than used oil recycling today. The rebrand confirms the association's commitment to represent and provide value to all members and their product and service offerings.

STAY CLOSE TO CORE & GROWTH ORIENTED.

During the initial steps of the association's rebrand, the association was advised that a primary factor in rebrand success was for organizations to stay close to their core. To that end, the association adopted a theme of 'adding, not changing' during the rebrand. *ENFINITE* will continue to focus on serving members that collect and recycle used oil, wastewater and antifreeze. Research indicates that over 70% of members also provide industrial and environmental services and collect a broader array of industrial liquids, including hazardous and specialty waste. The rebrand and corresponding diversification strategy stays close to the core because members are already in these spaces.

GENERIC & SPECIFIC.

Prior to the start of the rebrand, a company that decided not to join said the reason was his company "is not really an oil recycling company." However, that company did provide oil recycling services, plus many other services. It is just that their primary service offering was not oil recycling. It was important that the new name of the association reflect the broader array of member service offerings while still understanding members are broadly connected by their industrial liquid recycling activities.
