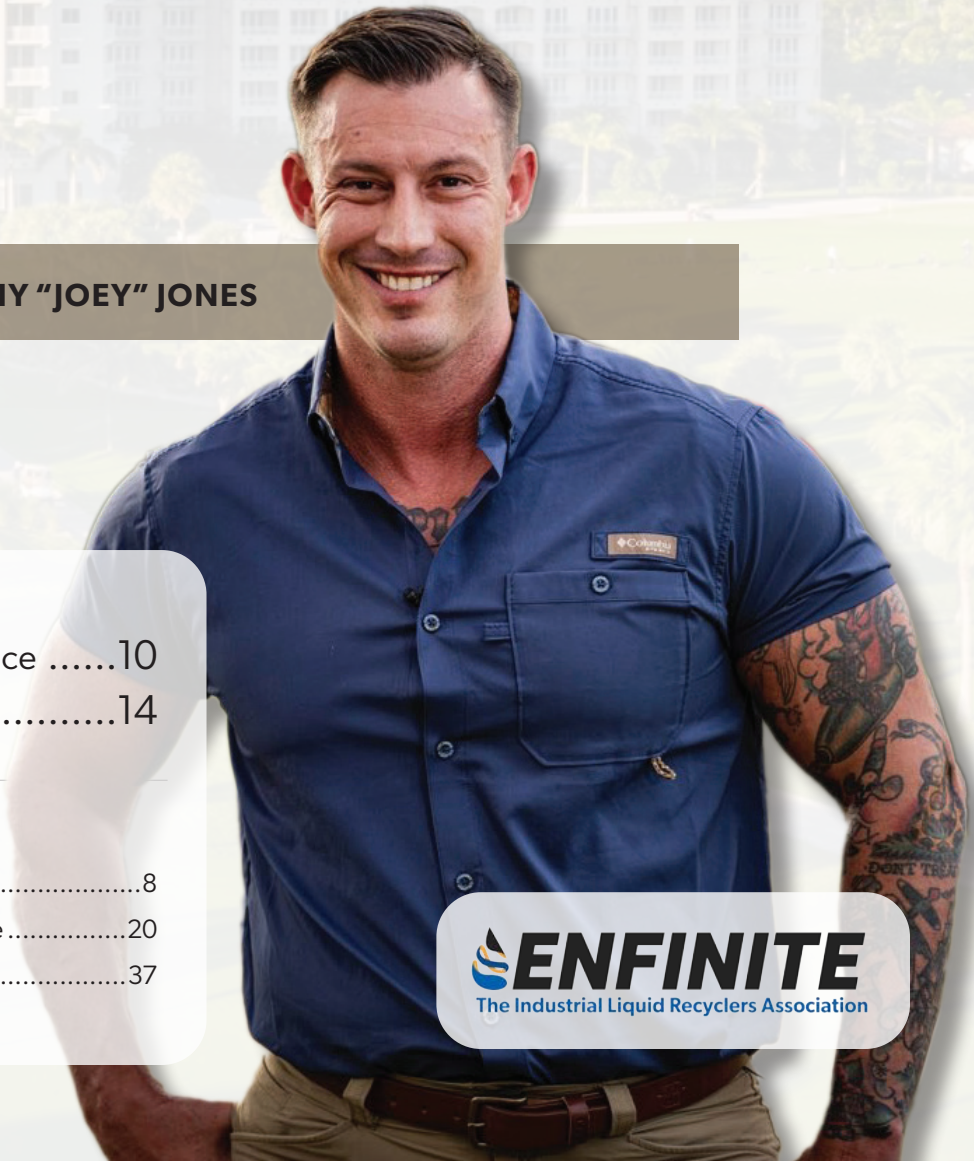

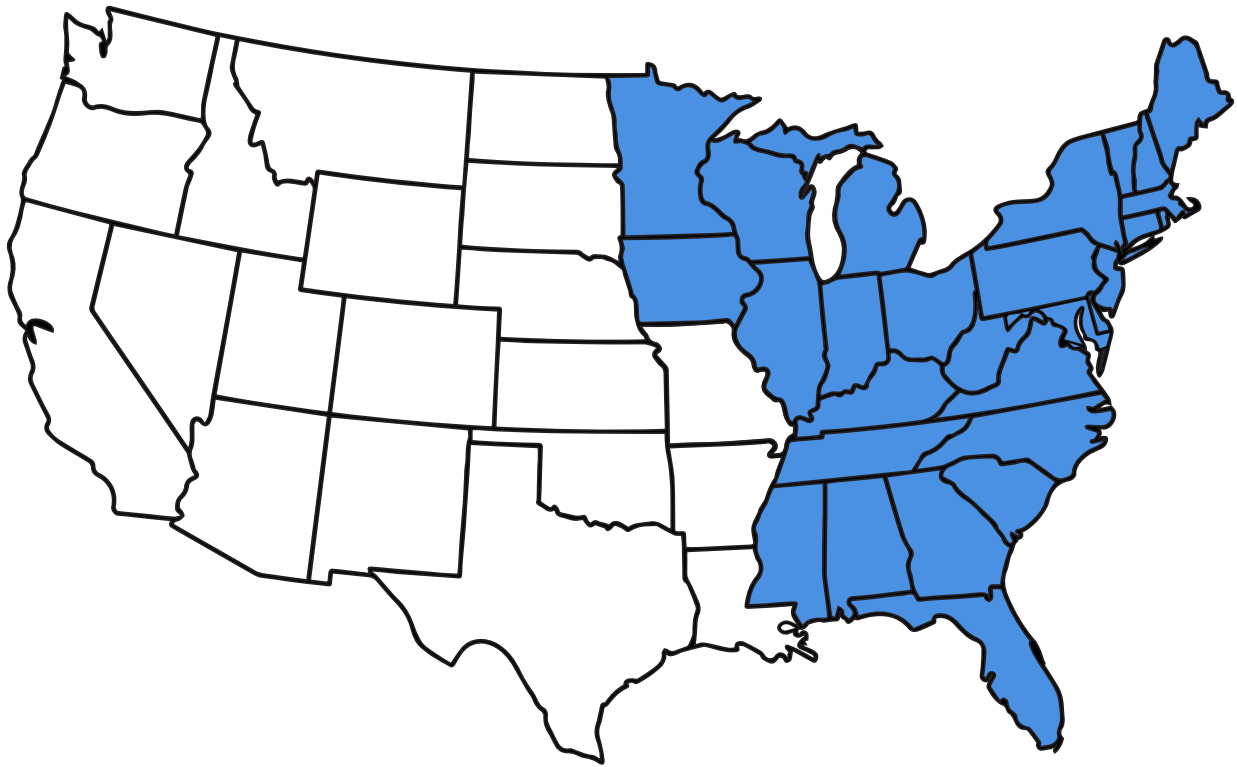

PARKER'S POINT

What If Our Industry Did Not Exist?

Energy has always been a driver in improving the quality of life.

For thousands of years, wood was the fuel for warmth and cooking. Coal powered steam engines in the early 1700s. From 1700-1850, whale oil provided fuel and lubrication making it the fifth largest industry in the US in 1846.

By 1850, the world's population was 1.2 billion people. Global average life expectancy was 29.3 years. 87% of the world's population was living in extreme poverty.

In 1859, the discovery of oil through drilling happened in Titusville, Pennsylvania.

Today, the world's population is 8.2 billion people. Global average life expectancy is 73.2 years. Less than 10% of the world's population lives in extreme poverty today.

Why? Oil has been a driving force in generating these results in just 166 years.

There have also been unfortunate negative environmental impacts related to oil, including the generation of billions of gallons of industrial liquids each year that no longer serve their purpose. Untreated industrial liquid waste wreak havoc on our planet and waste valuable products.

That is where ENFINITE members come in. We work to recycle and reuse industrial liquid waste to transform them into usable products.

But, what if our industry did not exist?

Over a billion gallons of used oil would not be collected and recycled into base lubricants or fuel. The US EPA has declared that one gallon of used oil can make a million gallons of fresh water undrinkable.

Billions of gallons of industrial wastewater would go untreated. There would be no centralized wastewater treatment facilities processing difficult to treat waste creating major challenges for public water authorities to provide clean drinking water.

Used oil filters, glycol, paint, solvent, ink, specialty waste, expired products and more would not be recycled wasting valuable resources. Not to mention the industrial, field and emergency services that would not happen without ENFINITE members.

Bottomline, our industry needs to do a better job telling the story of the importance of the industrial liquid recycling industry. The ENFINITE Board of Directors has approved funding for a new website that will do just that. Stay tuned for a brand new website that will promote all members and the industry.

Missouri to Ban VTAE

Effective July 1, 2025, the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) is implementing a significant update to its asphalt binder specifications. It will now prohibit the use of re-refined engine oil bottoms (REOB) and vacuum tower asphalt extenders (VTAE) in any binder supplied for its projects. ENFINITE will host a Zoom meeting for its re-refinery members to discuss a project to support the environmental benefits of VTAE.

Fleet Safety and Auto Insurance:

A Guide For ENFINITE Members

Whether hazardous or non-hazardous, liquids are sensitive in nature and require stringent procedures to protect personnel, the environment, and the public. Fleet safety and auto insurance are critical components of operational success and resiliency for businesses that transport liquids. If you have been involved in your company's insurance program renewals, you are well aware that the frequency and severity of auto claims have increased dramatically over the past decade, directly impacting your premiums. Safety culture is a source of tremendous pride within any successful organization. Constantly challenging your people and procedures, and adapting your educational methods, will keep your organization ahead of the pack. Working with your insurance broker to showcase your people, processes and performance to the insurance underwriting community will help you negotiate more competitive rates and coverage.

As you educate your employees and insurance carriers on your fleet risk, make sure your communications incorporate the following:

Top Safety Concerns with Pulling Liquids

The physical properties, such as weight distribution, movement during transit, and potential for spills or leaks are unique

to liquids. Below are the key safety concerns and solutions to mitigate risks:

1. Material Compatibility

Ensuring that container materials are compatible with the liquid being transported. Incompatible materials can lead to chemical reactions, corrosion, or leaks, posing significant safety hazards. Verify that containers are designed to handle the specific liquid being transported.

2. Capacity and Size

Using the correct container size is essential to prevent overfilling or underutilization. Overfilled containers increase the risk of spills, while underfilled containers may lead to excessive liquid movement (sloshing), which can destabilize the vehicle during transit or reduce the efficiency of your operations.

3. Ventilation

Liquids that emit gases or vapors can build pressure within a sealed container. Proper ventilation systems are necessary to allow these gases to dissipate safely, reducing the risk of explosions or container failure.

4. Security Features

Containers should be equipped with secure locking mechanisms and spill containment features to prevent accidental leaks or unauthorized access. This is particularly important when transporting hazardous or regulated liquids.

5. Regular Inspections

Routine inspections of containers and vehicles are vital to identify potential issues such as rust, wear and tear, or leaks. Addressing these problems can prevent accidents and ensure compliance with safety regulations.

6. Training and Emergency Preparedness

Provide comprehensive training to drivers and personnel on safe handling practices. A current and comprehensive emergency response plan will help minimize the impact of accidents, their impacts and minimize costs.

Driver Credentialing: Ensuring Compliance and Safety

Driver credentialing is a critical aspect of fleet safety and compliance. Hazardous material or bulk liquid loads require specialized endorsements and certifications to ensure compliance with federal and state regulations. Key credentials and endorsements include:

1. Hazardous Materials (Hazmat) Endorsement

- Purpose: Required for drivers transporting hazardous materials, including flammable, corrosive, or toxic liquids.
- Requirements: Drivers must pass a written knowledge test, undergo a Transportation Security Administration (TSA) background check, and meet state-specific requirements.
- Importance: Ensures that drivers are knowledgeable about the risks associated with hazardous materials and are prepared to handle emergencies safely.

2. Tanker Endorsement

- Purpose: Required for drivers operating vehicles designed to transport liquids in bulk, such as tankers.
- Requirements: Drivers must pass a written knowledge test that covers topics such as liquid surge, vehicle stability, and safe driving practices for tankers.
- Importance: Addresses the unique challenges of transporting liquids, such as sloshing and weight distribution, which can affect vehicle handling and stability.

3. Commercial Driver's License (CDL)

- Purpose: This should go without saying, but a CDL is mandatory for operating commercial vehicles, includ-

ing those used for transporting liquids.

- Requirements: Drivers must pass a general knowledge and skills test and meet medical fitness standards.
- Importance: Ensures that drivers have the foundational skills and knowledge to operate commercial vehicles safely.

4. Additional Training and Certifications

- Examples: Some companies may require additional certifications, such as OSHA training, spill response training, or first aid certification.
- Importance: Enhances driver preparedness and ensures compliance with company-specific or industry-specific safety standards.

5. Record Maintenance

- Driver Qualification Files (DQFs): Employers must maintain up-to-date records of driver credentials, including endorsements, medical certifications, and training history.
- Importance: Ensures compliance with Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations and provides documentation in the event of audits or inspections.

By ensuring that drivers possess the necessary credentials and endorsements, companies can reduce liability, enhance safety, and maintain compliance with regulatory requirements.

The Role of Fleet Safety in Risk Management

Fleet safety is a cornerstone of risk management for companies involved in liquid recycling. A well-maintained and safety-conscious fleet not only reduces the likelihood of accidents but also enhances operational efficiency and reputation.

Here are some best practices for fleet safety:

- Driver Training: Regular training programs for drivers on defensive driving, load management, and emergency response.
- Vehicle Maintenance: Scheduled maintenance checks to ensure vehicles are in optimal condition.
- Telematics and Monitoring: Use of GPS tracking and telematics systems to monitor driver behavior, vehicle speed, and route efficiency.
- Compliance with Regulations: Adherence to local, state, and federal transportation regulations, including those specific to hazardous materials.

Auto Insurance: A Critical Safeguard

Auto claims costs have skyrocketed over the past 10 years. Whether you have one tractor or a fleet of 2,000, the right program can protect you from financial stress or a catastrophic hit to your balance sheet. Partnering with a reputable insurance

broker with experience in your industry, will help you make informed decisions about how you transfer your risk, via insurance or contractually, while minimizing your costs.

Make sure your broker discusses the following with you:

- Coverage Types: Liability coverage, collision coverage, and comprehensive coverage. For fleets transporting hazardous materials, specialized coverage may be required.
- Policy Limits: Choose policy limits that adequately cover potential risks, including environmental clean-up costs in the event of a spill.
- Driver History: Insurance premiums are often influenced by the driving records of fleet operators. Investing in driver training and maintaining clean records can help reduce costs.
- Claims Process: Work with an insurance provider that offers a streamlined claims process and responsive customer service.



Third Party Haulers and Contractual Protection:

As the costs of insurance and claims have risen, claims against generators, waste brokers, or businesses hiring third parties to move waste on their behalf have also risen. Aside from protecting your business, a focus on contract requirements can increase the interest, and competition for your risk, amongst insurance carriers.

Contractual Considerations for 3rd Party Haulers:

- Ensure the 3rd party has adequate limits – minimum of \$1M. However, depending on what they are hauling, what states they operate in (CA, TX, LA, FL, NY – are examples of more litigious states, with certain counties being worse than others), consider \$2M or \$5M, and more for larger companies.

- Use reputable companies – don't use fly by night operations, vet them through websites, financials, references etc.
- Use known regional or countrywide carriers with a strong insurance program whenever possible.
- Require that you are listed as insured as additional insured on their policy that includes primary / non-contributory and waiver of subrogation language.

Establish Other Requirements:

- Hiring driver practice (background checks, MVR's, driver age/experience)
- Safety programs
- Use of telematics
- Transparency around subcontracting procedures.

Unfortunately, hiring a 3rd party does not shift 100% of potential liability. In fact, many times, the companies hiring the 3rd party transporters are brought back into the claims for various reasons – hiring negligence, 3rd party not having adequate insurance, deep pockets, etc. Do not accept less than you require of your own drivers and insurance.

Conclusion:

As an ENFINITE member, fleet safety, driver credentialing, auto insurance and contractual risk transfers are strategic investments in the sustainability and success of your business. How do you generate the greatest return on your investments in these areas? Partner with your broker to develop a relationship with your insurance carriers. Nobody can help an underwriter understand your business better than you can.

Meet with them prior to your renewal to update them on your business, safety and performance. Take advantage of their loss control services. Maintain an open dialogue over the course of the year. Taking the time to tell your story will pay dividends when you negotiate your renewals or work together to resolve a claim. ■

Leadership & Teamwork: Leadership Is Often Seen as a Binary – That Couldn't Be Furthest From the Truth

Leadership is often seen as a binary, you either lead or follow. That couldn't be the furthest from the truth. We lead one another in a gamut of ways every day. In the military, they even have a term for it, "Lead from the bottom" meaning every Marine, no matter their rank or position has the opportunity to do the right thing, make the tough choices, be consistent in their approach and lead by example. Good leaders don't always make the right decisions, but they also don't create doubt in their peers and subordinates about why they make the decisions they make. Leadership isn't about simply knowing a specific mission; it's about knowing the people working with you on it. They inspire one another to work harder, be more disciplined and accomplish the task by being genuine in our own effort, consistent in our diligence and fair in our assessments. Leadership isn't steering the boat, it's inspiring the rowers to row, the riggers to rig and the navigators to plot and stay on course.

Joey will share with ENFINITE attendees the importance of focusing on resilience, service, and finding purpose in adversity. He will share his personal journey as a Marine who lost both legs in Afghanistan, using his story to highlight perseverance, adaptability, and mental toughness. He will emphasize the importance of teamwork, leadership, and a

sense of mission. He will discuss how to turn life-changing setbacks into opportunities for growth, inspiring members to approach challenges with courage and gratitude.

Biography:

Combat-wounded Marine Staff Sergeant (Ret.) Johnny "Joey" Jones has transformed personal tragedy into a powerful mission—uplifting others through service, storytelling, and strength. After losing both legs in Afghanistan while serving as an Explosive Ordnance Disposal Technician, Joey became a nationally recognized voice for veterans, resilience, and recovery.
